Agreed unanimously. • The Clerk presented a Protocol for Co-opting to enable the Co-option of a new Councillor at the next meeting on 18th June 2018. After discussion and amendments the Protocol was agreed, Proposed by Cllr MS seconded by Cllr CM to adopt the Protocol, agreed unanimously. • The Clerk explained that there should be an amendment to our Standing Orders in order to be able to put the now accepted protocol into practice. Proposed Cllr MS, seconded Cllr CM to amend Thornborough Parish Council Standing Orders with the addition of the following: Item 8 Meetings Generally - after 't' and before 'u' proposed as a standing order: 'Co-option of a new Councillor can be voted on by a paper ballot. Ballot papers will be signed by Councillors and after resolution the ballot papers will be destroyed by the Clerk.' Agreed unanimously. • The Clerk reported that there were now three candidates who have expressed interest in the casual vacancy for a Councillor. Agreed that unless the Clerk hears from the Aylesbury Vale District Council Electoral Officer that there has been a legitimate request for an election, Thornborough Parish Councillors will vote to co-opt one of the candidates at the next meeting of the Council on 18th June 2018.
